

On the financial front we have \$1,202.74 in the IMB account. The National Treasurer requires the GST payment at the end of December each year. I have sent a cheque in the amount of \$19.87 for our Branch GST commitment.

Please check the expiry date on your Club membership card.

The National Club allows two months to renew after expiry and then the Club marks the details of expired members on the database as un-financial. Those members who wish to rejoin are then required to pay the joining fee. (31/12 is the expiry date for all cards).

Remember only financial members can vote at the AGM.


