Written-off vehicle - Cancellation of your vehicle registration

Roads and Maritime Services has been notified that your vehicle [REDACTED] has been notified to the NSW Written-off Vehicle Register. Your vehicle's registration was cancelled on [REDACTED] 2015.

Your Compulsory Third Party (CTP) insurance policy will be cancelled on [REDACTED] 2015. The *Road Transport Act 2013* requires the CTP insurance to continue for four (4) business days after the registration cancellation date. You may be entitled to a refund of the balance of your CTP insurance policy from your CTP insurer. Please note the date on which the CTP insurance refund amount is calculated is [REDACTED] 2015 and cannot be backdated. CTP insurance does not apply to trailers.

It is an offence to drive an unregistered or uninsured vehicle on a road or road related area.

Authorisation to repair

Written-off vehicles may not be registered, or have existing registration renewed or transferred, unless Roads and Maritime issues an Authorisation to Repair. An Authorisation to Repair will only be issued in limited circumstances.

To find out whether you are eligible to obtain an Authorisation to Repair, visit rms.nsw.gov.au/wov.

If you are considering repairing your vehicle, you should also obtain information from Roads and Maritime about the repair and inspection requirements for eligible written-off vehicles. If you have any enquiries about repairing an eligible written-off vehicle, please call 1300 364 847.

Number plates

You are responsible for the number plates issued to your vehicle. You must return the number plates to a Registry or Service NSW centre within 14 days of the registration cancellation date.

If you wish to use the number plates again, they must be reserved at a Registry or Service NSW centre. A reserve, and in some cases a Special Number Plate fee, applies.
